We have also provided you with robes and slippers, the slippers are for a once only use, they will be disposed of after your visit or you may take them if you would like keep them.

Bathrooms

There are fresh towels in both bathrooms and also we have provided you with beach towels, the coloured ones, please use these to go to the pool or beach.

Outdoor furniture, balconies etc

If there are any spillages or you need to do any cleaning there are cleaning products under the kitchen sink and cleaning tools in the cupboard by the entrance door.

If you do fill up the bins, all waste can be put into black bags provided, the main bin is at the front gate to the right, large flip top dumpster types, all Spanish just put everything in here include recycling.
